

Thus saith the Lord to United States: From the beginning of time every transgression of any law has met with just recompense. It is not because of a few transgressions that I send judgment upon you, but for many, many transgressions.

Woe to you who are in lethargy and ease in United States! You raise one sleepy eyelid and slowly ask, 'At ease—why not?' Do you not know that all of the nations are but fulfilling my plan and my laws and that fervent effectual prayers from your lips might divert my sure judgments? You trust in your great army and navy. Your air force is your pride. However, let us not forget, to humble our hearts and pray fervently, that war might cease.

United States, you have almost come to the time of the harvest—in fact you are over-ripe for the harvest. I have passed you by in judgments many, many times. Famines have stricken India and China. War has devastated the civilian populations of many countries. Why do you feel so secure?

Many of you can scarcely wait until the Sabbath is over so that you might gain the greatest profit. Others continue to work right through the Sundays year after year without going to church at the lnstead of worshipping the Lord, you lie and steal from the poor that you might add gain to your purses.

United States, I will never forget your doings in this twentieth century. Why do you not repent so that I might rain righteousness on you as when the nation was born and that your hearts might be satisfied with the approval of Jehovah?"

Palestine

It was a glorious event when on December 11, 1917, quietly and unostentatiously, without pomp or blare of trumpet, General Edmund Allenby, commander-in-chief of the Allied armies in the East, entered the city of Jerusalem and delivered Palestine from the tyranny of the Turks. Under their oppressive rule the people had suffered for centuries, and the once beautiful and fertile land had become barren and desolate. For ages the hearts of half the world had turned with devotion and longing toward this land of Canaan, which was the Promised Land of the Israelites and the birthplace of Christianity. By Jew, Christian, and Mohammedan alike it is reverenced as the Holy Land.

The saying has gone around the world, "Jerusalem was taken without a shot," but much blood was shed and many hard battles were fought before Jerusalem was entered. It was Allenby's plan to "press up into Judea by all available routes, and to throw a force into the rocky country north of Jerusalem astride the Jerusalem-Nablus road, with the purpose of forcing the Turks out of Jerusalem without allowing them to make a stand and fight in the Holy City." (1) The British followed out this plan from November 17 to December 9 but "every inch was tenaciously disputed by the Turks." The Turks were unsuccessful in trying to dislodge the British from Neby Samwil, the Mizpah of the Bible.

About noon of December 9, 1917, the mayor of Jerusalem surrendered the city. Allenby's plan of sparing the Holy City the ravages of war was successful for the Turks escaped during the night.

The taking of the city of Jesusalem was a notable feat of arms, but it was more than that; it was the fulfullment of prophecy. Nothing more sensational resulted from World War I.

The natives were certain that Allenby was a prophet sent from God, not only because of the deliverance wrought by him, but because his name sounded very much like two words, "Allah" (God), and "Neby" (Prophet).

It seemed only right and proper that the British should be given the mandate over Palestine at the end of the war. This mandate was intended for the assurance of equal rights, privileges, and protection for all concerned. After all, the British had fought and died for Palestine and they were unusually successful at colonial administration. Palestine belongs to the world in a sense which cannot be applied to any other land on the map.

On November 2, 1917, Mr. Arthur James Balfour, while Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, wrote to Lord Rothschild the letter which later became known as the Balfour Declaration and which has been since sanctioned by the governments of the nations of the United States, France, Italy and of the Allies, and was incorporated into the Treaty of San Remo.

He wrote:

"I have much pleasure in conveying to you on behalf of His Majesty's Government the following declaration of sympathy with Jewish Zionist aspirations which has been submitted to and approved by the Cabinet. His Majesty's Government views with favor the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people, and will use their best endeavors to facilitate the achievement of this object, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country. I should be grateful if you would bring this declaration to the knowledge of the Zionist Organization."

However, on June 21,1922, a motion to postpone the Mandate was carried on in the House of Lords, in spite of the Earl of Balfour's long and earnest plea in its favour.

POPULATION

It was always difficult to establish a correct census for Jerusalem. Not only has the city been in the habit of harboring many passing pilgrims but under the Turkish regime there were always people in hiding who seemed to disappear into the dark passages and loop-holes of the old city without apparently leaving any traces behind them. It was assumed that as soon as the British administration passed from the military to the civil stage one of its first efforts would be to obtain a reliable census of the inhabitants.

At the present time there are approximately 550,000 Jews in Palestine and about 1,200,000 Arabs. The population is now 144.5 persons per square mile as against 11.2 in Oregon, for example and if you were to increase it to 5,500,000 by adding 4,000,00 more Jews you would have a population density greater than that of Belgium, one of the most industrialized nations in the world.

The Arab spokesmen say that in 1922 the population of Palestine consisted of 486,177 Moslems and 83,790 Jews, while in 1942 it had grown to 925,510 Moslems and 481,706 Jews. Now the total is over 1,500,000 in an area of little more than 10,000 square miles of which the fertile portion is now taken up.

In the time of Christ the population was more than twice the figure that it is now and in the later Roman era it increased under intensive development and adequate protection from outside attack, to more than five million.

Jewish refugee immigration has been a considerable element in the past thirty years. The The Jewish population of Palestine was only 50, 000 in 1918. Now it is over 550,000, but in the meantime the Arab population has increased from

There is perhaps no field of human interest which arouses such bitter dispute as religion. We find this true all through the ages, from the first Church to the present date. But first, let us know the explanation of religion. What is religion? Religion is that which deals with man's relationship to a god and all ceremonies attendant upon that belief. All nations of the world have some mode of religion. Some of these are Paganism, Judaism, Buddhism, Catholicism, and Christianity.

America was founded on religious principles. The sacredness of human personality; the Institution of the home, marriage, and children; the virtues of honesty, justice, diligence; these are much more deeply rooted in the Christian tradition than we realize.

Juvenile deliquency is one of our most important problems. Solomon said, "Train up a child in the way that it should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it." The homes of thousands of youth are sadly neglected. Mothers and fathers are working in factories or plants, and in many instances are divorced ,and the child is placed in someone else's care. If the worst should come, and this generation of our American youth becomes the "lost generation" it will be the direct result of parents' sins and neglect.

The leaders of organized institutions of religion know that which is impressed upon the mind of the child before the age of seven molds and shapes the child's character. The home, the church, and the community all contribute to the character development of the child, but it is the classroom teacher that is privileged to have contact with the pupil during the most of his waking hours than perhaps any one individual. It is estimated that approximately one-half of the children in the United States receive no religious instruction outside the home. This statement from the 1940 White House Conference on Children in a Democracy is backed up by a bulletin of the School of Education, Indiana University, 1937.

Religion In The Lives Of Our Youth-Contd.

The Jews do not include the New Testament in their Scriptures. It must not be forgotten that the public schools belong quite as much to those men and women in our population who reject entirely the belief in the sacred character of this ancient literature and who object having it taught to their children, as they do to the religious groups.

Here is a testimony of one of our college professors, "Personally, I should be very happy to have the teaching of the Bible introduced into the public schools provided it could be done in the same manner in which any other literature is studied, but this is manifestly impossible because of the way in which the Bible is entangled in the religious emotions of the people. Those of our public schools that teach our Bible do so on a very low scale. Instead, they teach false theories of evolution and often make disparging remarks about the Bible, its moral and its miracles. It is those who are before the children, whose voices the children hear, whose manners and attitudes the children absorb: it is those individuals who should be so carefully selected.

There are only two strongholds left for parents who would do God's will and lead their children right; these are the church and the home.

We need more than just a knowledge of the Bible. It must be experienced and lived in the home, before the children will realize that it is

500,000 to over a million. The total number of Christians has remained static at about 125,000.

THE JEWS IN PALESTINE

At least 30,000 Jews are enlisted in the British army. Few of them are native to Palestine, however, but they are from at least 35 different nations. Palestine regiments have been serving with the British since Dunkerque, but they included Arabs as well as Jews. These Jews tell you that they are enlisted but for one puropse, and that for revenge. Among them is an almost fanatic belief in the necessity for a Jewish state in Palestine. Their songs are in Hebrew. Most of them were born in central Europe and German would have been the most common convenient language, but they say it is worth a man's life to utter it. By agreement, true Hebrew is the accepted tongue, although to many of them it was almost as foreign as Icelandic. These Jews are bound together because of a common bondage—the fact that they are Jews. Previous to their going to Palestine they bore the stamp of their own naionality-German, Dutch, etc., but now they have been "made" Jews.

Living in Palestine among his people is Dr. Chaim Weizman, the president of the Zionist movement. He is seventy years old. Dr. Weizman is a naturalized Russian scientist, formerly a professor of organic chemistry at the University of Manchester, England. He was given great honor and a homeland for his people upon his discovery of acetone during the last world war. Today Dr. Weizman lives in Rehovoth, Palestine, and heads the Hebrew University at Jerusalem and the Daniel Sieff Research Institute. Under his leadership Palestine has grown into a well-run community of over a half million Jews.

The Jews have poured millions of dollars into Palestine. New Jerusalem is a modern city, while Tel Aviv has a population of 200,000. Several industries such as diamond cutting, the manufacture of pharmaceutical products have been developed. The improvement in health has been very noticeable. Palestine has always been a land of trachoma and much blindness. (The writer has just talked with Sister Louise Dickson, a returned missionary from Palestine, who says that the land is overrun with blind people.) The Jews have founded the 250 bed hospital-Hadassah which is a \$1,000,000 institution.

Many thousands of acres have been reclaimed and put to productive use. The rocky soil has been terraced, many trees have been planted, and the swamps have been drained—all this has been done by the Jews.

In the Jordan River Valley where the land is 17 per cent salt some young Jews have piped the sweet water from the Jordan onto the land and let it soak down through so that it carried off the salt. This was done 80 times in eight months and products reaped after a planting showed a great increase in size.

For the Jews feel that they, at least, have

a home which belongs to them, freed from such signs as "Restricted Clientele," and "Jews not allowed."

The Jews have raised the standard of living in Palestine. An unskilled laborer gets \$1.60 a day and stone masons as high as \$4.00 a day. This has caused an influx of Arabs.

DAMMING THE JORDAN

Plans for making a modern irrigation system are being developed by the Commission on Palestine Surveys at the request of Dr. Chaim Weizman. This calls for a 200 million dollar project. Such a project would transform Palestine's agricultural and economical economy and make room for many more Jewish settlers. It would also serve as a model for the entire Near East.

Ralph Peary has sent his observations by recent air mail from Palestine on the above project. He says it will be comparable to the Boulder Dam, the Alaskan Highway or the George Washington Bridge and will completely rejuvenate the ancient land of Palestine.

Such a project calls for the use of all the preflow of the Jordan River for irrigation. To offset the drying up of the Dead Sea a proposed tunnel 20 miles long from the Mediterranean is planned. Because this water would take a 1300 feet drop from the Dead Sea it is planned to use it for the turning of turbines generating electricity.

Dr. Walter C. Lowdermilk, Assistant Chief of the Soil Conservation, Service of the United States Department of Agriculture spent a year in Palestine with a staff of experts planning this project.

Dr. Lowdermilk believes that about half the cost could be underwritten by various interested governments and the other half can be secured from Jewish philanthropists, also millions of Christians who would like to share in the rejuvenation of the Holy Land. There will be almost immediate returns from the sale of electricity, profits from increased extraction of minerals and year round crops.

Although the Arabs insist that there is room for no more Jews, Dr. Lowdermilk has been impressed with the number of abandoned villages, indicating the ancient density of population. "There are literally thousands of these cities, bankrupted by wars, exploitation, and soil erosion." (The wars of the Arabs, the Turkish rule held no hope for improvement of Palestine.)

- (2) The sale of land to Jews to be restricted to certain specified areas;
- (3) No Jewish immigration after March, 1944, but this restriction does not include some 33,000 still to arrive;
- (4) Within ten years the British Government will re-examine the Palestine question with a view to granting local autonomy.

The terrorist Jews of which there are two groups are bitterly and openly opposing the White Paper. The murder of Sir Walter Edward Guinness, first Baron Moyne, British Resident Minister in the Middle East on Nov. 6, 1944, by the Sternists is the most recent example of the activities of this Gang. The Stern Gang was formed when in 1941, Abraham Stern organized the Sternists as a continuing terror society. The Irgun terror society preceded this and both are secret societies.

The activities of the terroristic groups are looked upon with disfavor by Jewish leaders such as Dr. Chaim Weizman, and Dr. S. S. Wise, president of the American Jewish Congress. Dr. Wise has attributed these activities to a "group of misguided youths," while Dr. Weizman has pleaded with them for patience saying that Britain is "destined to become guardian of Israel's hope."

In contrast to the terrorist movements the New Zionist Organization demand the following:

- (1) British relinquishment of the Palestine mandate.
- (2) Jewish representation among the United Nations.
- (3) Exchange of populations between the Arabs and the Jews.
- (4) Acceptance by the United States of responsibility for fulfillment of the Balfour Declaration's provisions of the mandate.

UNITED STATES INTERVENTION IN TERRORIST ACTIVITIES

Both Democrat and Republican platforms of 1944 called for the transformation of Palestine into a Jewish commonwealth. The State Department, however, has not encouraged and intervention. The new secretary, Mr. Stettinius, has advised that a "hands off" policy is best. When a group of Palestine Arabs consulted with President Roosevelt in June, 1944, they were advised that perhaps one of the first questions to be considered by the World Organization would be that of the Palestine question.

After the Moyne murder 251 terrorists were deported to other countries because of their recent activities.

THE ARABS

Although the Jews want unrestricted immigration up to four millions, the Arabs say that they will not tolerate any more Jewish immigrants, but are willing to stand on the White Paper. The Arabs want autonomy for Palestine, while the Jews because of their smaller numbers do not wish it.

The Arabs point out the fact that the original movement for the Jews to return to Palestine was one of religious motivation and that at the present time the Jews are busily industrializing Palestine. The Arabs also say that the country cannot support four million immigrants. (According to figures Palestine has only 2,200,000 acres of productive farm land.) The Jews point to their exports in dense of industrialization.

The Arab has never been progressive and has comparatively few spokesmen. They are pointing to the next generation which is being educated in Palestine's schools for leaders, but they realize that they are already one generation late. They own most of the livestock in Palestine and protest bitterly at the suggestion of deportation to make room for Jews, for they feel that Palestine is as much their homeland as the Jews because of the fact that they have been there for hundreds of years. The Arabs point to the Jewish "bottomless" purse and to the contrasting fact that they have been under Turkish domination for many years with no outside help. On the other hand, the Jews say that the great improvements made by bringing in of Jewish money is reflected in whatever improvements the Arabs have made. (We cannot help but wonder what would happen to the Arab if the present prosperity derived from the Jews were taken away?)

RUSSIA?

The constant unrest because of Britain's policies toward Palestine, her accusation by others of carrying water on two shoulders in order to avail herself of the friendship or help of both the Arabs and the Jews has brought to the forefront the possibility of Palestine's friendship with another nation—Russia. There are two reasons for such a likely friendship:

- (1) Russia is closer geographically.
- (2) Since, 1917, whatever else they have done, Russia has not restorted to racial persecution.

A recent speaker suggested as one of the probable remedies that certain European statesmen set about doing constructive things for the Near East. He also spoke against Britain's lust for imperialism and her desire for colonies as over against allowing autonomy for the smaller nations.

We know, too, that during the last twenty-five years all the 7 European nations with Arabian interests have besmirched the name of the Soviet Union, telling the religious Arabs that they would be brought under a Godless regime. Soviet Russia has for years wanted an outlet to the eastern Mediterranean and the Arabian Sea. We can expect Russia to seek some sort of friendship with Palestine because of these interests.

Britain's distrust of Zionism seems to have a special stumblingblock in the appointment of a certain concession to Pinhas Rutenberg, a Russian Jew for the harnessing of the water powers of Palestine. Rutenberg has no funds of his own, but has obtained them through the Zionist Organization.

We read in the 12th chapter of Genesis that because of Abram's faithfulness he was promised the land of Palestine. WAR EXPERIENCES IN FRANCE HOLLSOPPLE, PA.

In the November issue of the Outlook we asked you to remember Bro Eldon Stahl, son of the pastor, who is serving with the General Hospital in France, in your prayers.

The hospital was moved closer to the front for more convenient admission of the wounded. In the latter part of November the hospital was struck by a V1 Robot bomb. Some people were killed and a fire followed. After reading in the newspaper and hearing the report on the radio that a General Hospital had been bombed in Belgium, a conviction came upon me that it was my son's hospital, but the Lord gave me assurance he was safe, although I felt it was a crisis or a sorrow to him, as the weeks went by.

Finally a letter came through to his wife of just what had taken place. One Trinity Pentecost prother from the Philadelphia, Pa., area, who was the postman was among the injured, and another close friend of our son's was instantly killed across the hall from Eldon's office. He was a Salvation Army brother and had only testified the evening before at prayer meeting how wonderful and merciful our Saviour is. He left a wife and little son behind in Bloomington, Illinois. Another friend who was in the same place was injured and will carry scars for life. Eldon's office was completly demolished and the fire that followed ruined everything. Our son who is responsible for get-

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ting food supplies in for the hospital, made it a practice to do so the first thing in the morning; however, God was gracious to him, by delaying his return to the hospital, as the train held him up for about 5 minutes that morning.

He stated in his last letter, "God has graciously undertaken in my life, and I know He has in many numerous instances. Do not worry, but hold fast in your prayers. Oh! that people in America would pray now and forget about themselves. I see hundreds upon hundreds of wounded men, and I am sure the larger percentage of American people are not conscious enough about the fact that war is a terrible thing."

The last week in November we had a very interesting and helpful Bible Conference here at the church. Elder L. J. Roshon of Basil, Ohio, was the instructor. On November 30th we had a mortgage burning service in charge of District Elder W. T. Poling of Morgantown, W. Va. Evangelistic services during this time were in charge of Elder Jewel Cole of Parkersburg, W. Va. Other visiting ministers who attended and helped with our services were Elders H. C. Weaver, R. V. Siverling, Dan Gray; Sisters Mary Ann Gray, Mabel Porter and Martha Leonard.

The local United Brethren pastor and wife also enjoyed several sessions with us. One sister who had drifted away from God was restored to fellowship with God in our meetings.
